PRESCHOOL I AM AND PRESCHOOL I PM SESSIONS

- 🐾 Students must be 3 by August 31st
- 🐾 Classes will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays
- 🐾 There will be AM (8:30-11:00) and PM (12:30-3:00) sessions
- 🐾 14 students per class; Student/Teacher Ratio 7:1

The Preschool I program includes developmentally appropriate play-based opportunities for creative, emotional, social, intellectual, physical and spiritual growth. Self-confidence is nurtured while creativity and self-expression are emphasized through art and music. This session provides a good balance between free time and structure. Large and small motor development, readiness skills and socialization are encouraged by the use of building toys, sensory tables, home living center, books, puzzles, art table, manipulative, free choice and outdoor play. The idea of God's love for everyone is fostered through stories, prayer, song and discussion. By discussing everyday Catholic values the children are encouraged to practice sharing, honesty, kindness and cooperation. A strong foundation is laid for further development of readiness skills.

PRESCHOOL II SESSION

- 🐾 Students must be 4 by August 31st.
- 🐾 Class Times: Mondays 8:30-10:30, Wednesdays, Fridays, 8:30-11:00

The Preschool II program is developmentally appropriate. The children learn to enhance the many skills they are now capable of doing. Special emphasis is placed upon the development of social responsibility and spiritual growth. Open exploration, as well as, teacher directed activities include opportunities for whole group, small group and individualized learning styles. Different learning styles are addressed and the development of a child's strengths is encouraged while instilling confidence and maturity. A daily variety of opportunities encourage the development of readiness skills including pre-reading, mathematics, whole language, art, science, social studies, and motor development. The children are preparing for success in the formalized school environment of kindergarten.

PRESCHOOL II ENRICHMENT

This session offers an extra day for enrichment in the arts, sciences, handwriting, math and reading readiness skills in a small group setting of 8 children. Special emphasis will be placed on small group cooperative play, individual and group activities, and social development.

- 🐾 Must be enrolled in Preschool II
- 🐾 Classes will be held on Tuesdays OR Thursdays from 8:30-11:00AM
- 🐾 8 students per session.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN

- 🐾 Students must be 5 by December 31st. The Pre-Kindergarten will be held 4 days a week on Monday from 12:00-2:00 and 12:30-3:00 Tuesday, Thursday, and Wednesday **or** Friday.
- 🐾 Wednesdays and Friday sessions will be limited to 8 students in each session. (One-half of the class (8 students) will attend on Wednesday and the other half of the class (8 students) will attend on Fridays.
- 🐾 Total enrollment will be 16 students

The Pre-Kindergarten class for older 4 and 5 year olds offers additional enrichment designed to further encourage and expand a child's intellectual, spiritual, creative, motor and social skills. The Pre-Kindergarten class is just that, a class before kindergarten. It allows children to continue at their own rate of development while instilling confidence and maturity. This curriculum was created with age appropriate activities to stretch and challenge older preschoolers in the following areas: logical-mathematical concepts, whole language, spiritual growth, social responsibility, sciences, social studies and art. The children will have the opportunity to expand their knowledge and gain a longer attention span, social readiness skills, and large and small muscle control. This program is designed for older 4's and 5 year olds who would benefit from an extra year of preschool before entering the formalized school setting of kindergarten. This program will be held 4 days a week.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN PLUS

The Pre-Kindergarten Plus adds an extra day to the Pre-Kindergarten program for a total of 5 days. The additional 5th day will add age appropriate curriculum with enhanced science and math concepts, emersion in visual and fine arts, and expand their knowledge of the world around us. The extra 5th day will have a maximum of 8 students per session. It will also give the Pre-Kindergarteners the opportunity to expand their opportunity to be part of the larger Holy Family School community and activities.

Children, who are 5 by January 31, may be considered for the Pre-Kindergarten Programs based on placements guidelines and availability of space.

The curriculum in the Preschool II and Pre-Kindergarten classes works toward your child's success in kindergarten. Students in both the Preschool II and Pre-Kindergarten classes will be eligible for kindergarten in the fall of 2011.



Admission Process

The admission process begins on Wednesday, January 13th, with an early bird deadline of Tuesday, January 26, 2010, and a final deadline of Thursday, February 4, 2010. Applications received after February 4th will be considered on an individual basis.

Completed applications may be dropped off in the Holy Family Parish School office or mailed to Holy Family Parish Preschool, 7338 120th Ave. NE Kirkland, Washington 98033.

In order for your application to be complete we will need the following:

- Completed application form
- A copy of your child's birth certificate
- Completed parent questionnaire
- \$25 application fee

Letters of acceptance will be mailed in early to mid- February. The \$175 new family registration fee will be due upon acceptance with tuition contract.

We will try to honor your first preference for classes, but please remember:

- Pre-Kindergarten classes are only for those who will be 5 by December 31, 2010.
- The Preschool II and Enrichment classes are for those who will be 4 by August 31, 2010 and not 5 by December 31, 2010.
- The Pre-Kindergarten and Preschool II classes prepare students for entrance into kindergarten in September 2011.
- Preschool I students will be confirmed as to morning or afternoon sessions in mid-March.

 - Financial contributions made on a regular basis
 - Participation in volunteer service to the parish or preschool
- 🐾 Catholics outside of the parish
- 🐾 Others
