For those students 5 years old by December 31, 2011, there is the opportunity to choose between two Pre-Kindergarten Programs:



PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM

A 4-day program held on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday afternoons with a 4th day of either Wednesday (A) or Friday (B) afternoon.



PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM PLUS

A 5-day program held on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday afternoons. The additional 5th day will emphasize and integrate the following: science and math, visual and fine arts, and the world around us.
